Working Towards Reducing Plastic Waste

A portion of plastic waste produced within Gifu Prefecture flows from rivers into the ocean and contributes to marine pollution. Around 70% of waste which washes up on coasts is plastic waste, around half of which is single-use plastic used for food and drink. Gifu Prefecture is promoting initiatives to reduce the amount of single-use plastic produced and thus reduce the overall amount of plastic waste.
