Announcement Don't Forget to Complete Transfer Procedures for National Health Insurance after Moving House

Following reforms to the National Health Insurance System, from April 1, health insurance will be unified at a prefectural level. As a result, if you move to another municipality within Gifu prefecture, you will no longer need to withdraw from and rejoin the National Health Insurance System. However, you must still complete transfer procedures at your new municipality of residence in order for your new insurance card to be issued. Payments of health insurance contributions (tax), as well as all applications and notifications related to health insurance, will continue to be processed through your municipality of residence.

Announcement Registration Procedures to begin for Private Lodging Services (Minpaku)

A new law prescribing operation rules for *minpaku* services, which rent out private housing as accommodation, comes into effect on June 15 (Fri.). As such, advance procedures to register private lodgings will be available from March 15 (Thurs.).
