



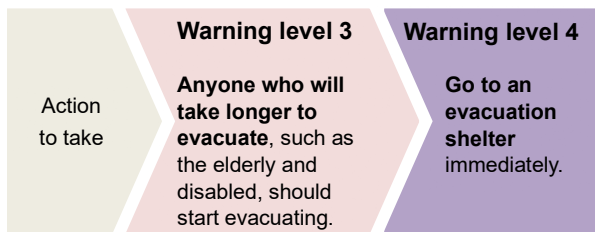

Protecting Yourself in a Natural Disaster

When a wind or water-related disaster or landslide occurs or is likely to occur, municipalities will issue evacuation information according to the warning level. This is important, life-saving information, so be sure to understand the content and the differences between different types of warnings, and evacuate early.



Warning level 5 means that a disaster has already occurred. Take action to protect your life.

Points to remember when evacuating

- Confirm evacuation routes and the location of evacuation sites in advance, and choose to evacuate early.
- Avoid dangerous areas such as near rivers when evacuating.

Preventing Food Poisoning

Take the following preventative measures to prevent food poisoning caused by bacteria prevalent in the summer months.

① Don't leave bacteria on surfaces.

Make sure to wash food, hands and fingers, and cooking utensils well.

② Don't increase bacteria

Put perishable foods such as meat and fish in the fridge as soon as you buy them.

③ Kill bacteria

Heat food thoroughly before eating.

Goal 2: Zero Hunger

The total amount of food waste produced each year in Japan amounts to over 6 million tons (enough to fill around 1700 large trucks every day). This waste comes from food which could be eaten but is thrown away as leftovers or unsold food. Gifu Prefecture is promoting *Gifu Tabekiri Undo* (Gifu "clean your plate" movement) with the cooperation of restaurants and similar businesses.
